- We do not tolerate any form of threat of harm, actual harm, bullying or discrimination against our young volunteers
- Any incident should be reported to our designated liaison persons **Frances Kelly** or **Máire Uí Scolaí**
- We fully respect confidentiality requirements in dealing with child protection matters.

Potential risks

Risk of harm not being recognised by members of the committee or volunteers

Risk of harm not being reported properly or promptly to the committee or designated liaison person

Risk of a child being harmed by a member of the committee or a volunteer

Risk of a child being harmed by another child

Risk of harm due to bullying of a child

Risk of harm due to inadequate supervision of children

If you feel at risk or suffer any harm, bullying or other danger, report it to one of our liaison persons and to your parents / guardians immediately

If you witness any risk to our young volunteers report it immediately
